Itinerary for Keeper for the Day

You will get the chance to work on some of our sections along side our dedicated zoo keeping team during your experience.

10:00am - 10:30am

Arrival & Documentation

- Once you have arrived at our main entrance, speak to a member of staff who will let us know you have arrived. We will then meet you at the zoo entrance.
- You will then be able to get yourself ready for the day which will include a health and safety briefing.
- We will provide you with outer clothing for the experience.
- A zookeeper will come and collect you to begin your experience.

10:30am - 12:00pm Mucking Out

- You'll get the opportunity to work with a range of species which may include Tapir, Ostrich and Kangaroo. You will need long sleeves for this part of the experience.

12:00pm - 1:00pm Lunch Break

- You will have an hour for lunch. You will be given a meal voucher which can be used at any of the following outlets (subject to availability): Burger Kitchen, Chicken Diner, Tea Shop Café.

1:00pm - 2:30pm Animal Diets

- You'll get the chance to prepare and deliver diets to our small monkeys such as Tamarins and Marmosets, or larger primates such as Spider Monkeys, Macaques and Gibbons.

2:30pm - 3:00pm Husbandry

- You'll be able to go behind the scenes in our Reptile House and assist our Reptile Keeper with his daily routine of looking after them.

3:00pm - 4:00pm Enrichment & Training

- Meet our Meerkat Mob and create their enrichment for the day, you will then give this to our mischievous mob. To round off your day, get the chance to meet Tika and Pema our 2 Red Pandas.

4:00pm Home time

- You'll be escorted back to the staff welfare facilities where you will receive your Zoo Keeper for the Day Certificate, clean up and get ready to go home.
